


# Amateur Radio Club

From time to time we have given training classes on the usage of FRS (Family Radio Service) Radios. While we do not expect everyone to remember all the complexities of these radios, the most common two Buttons folks have trouble with are setting the channel # and the PL tone..

Below is a diagram on how to do this. Clip this out and keep with your radio and do attend another FRS training class to practice.

## How to Program / Operate a Family Radio Service (FRS) Radio in 5 Easy Steps:



**1. Turn knob clockwise to power on and adjust volume.**

**2. Press MENU button once, the display will show a flashing channel number from 1 to 22.**

**3. Press (-) or (+) buttons to change channel.**

**4. Press the PTT [Push To Talk] button to set Channel.**

**5. Press to talk! PTT Button**

**Press MENU button twice, the display will show a flashing PL Tone from 1 to 200. Select via +/- then Press PTT button to save.**
